


Goals

 - Effective and efficient utilisation of resources; and
 - Improved compliance with environmental regulatory framework.






Status of designated Waste Management Officers: WC






Municipal IWMP assessment analysis

All 30 muns have 2nd generation plans






Status municipal by-laws





Status households refuse removal









Waste generation distribution per district

 Total of 8.2 mil tons of waste generate (CSIR Baseline Study 2012)






Waste Quantities WC




Municipal Solid Waste WC - 2018

Local Muns reporting waste quantities






Municipalities with S@S

WCG Response to landfill airspace challenges

WCG Policy to promote regionalisation waste management services

- Authorize only new regional waste disposal facilities in the future due high operational cost and reduce environmental impacts of non-complaint smaller WDFs – inline with National Development Plan – post 2030.
- Regionalisation for waste management services should not solely focus on regional WDFs but preferably on the <u>whole waste service</u>.


Aggressive waste diversion, recovery and beneficiation of waste material:

- Focus initially on interventions on waste streams such as <u>organic waste and construction</u>
 <u>& demolition waste</u>:
 - Set diversion targets for organic waste 50% diversion of organic waste from landfill by 2022; and
 - Landfill ban of organic waste to landfill by 2027.
- Focus on waste separation at source.
- Promote waste economy & job creation.
- Alternative waste treatment.






Alternative waste treatment
