Summary

- The Department of Environmental Affairs in partnership with National Treasury coordinates the implementation of National Green Fund.
- Development Bank of Southern Africa (DBSA) is the implementing Agency.
- To date a total of 45 projects have been approved within the 3 Green Fund focus areas, with total value of approximately R722 500
 000 million.







Establishment of Green Fund

- Government allocated R1,1 billion for Green Fund for the financial years 2012/13 (R300 000 000.00),2013/14 (R250 000 000.00) and 2014/2015 (R250 000 000.00) & 2015/2016 (R216 000 000).
- The Green Fund represents a critical resource mechanism to accelerate the transition to a low carbon, resource efficient and pro-employment growth path.
- Key components being funded include: Low carbon/CDM investment projects implementation, Research & Development and Capacity Building.
- Based on the components being supported through the Green Fund, it will provide an evidence base from lessons learnt which will inform future policy direction.

Green Fund Eligibility Criteria

- **Relevance**: match to the funding Window and focus areas therein
- **Innovation**: the project is new and unique in the green economy space. This innovation can relate to any of the following aspects: technology, business model, institutional arrangements, or financing approach.
- Additionality: the project cannot proceed without the Green Fund's financial support and a funding gap should be demonstrated.
- Ability to scale up and/or replicate: the project has the potential to be rolled out to other sites and/ or to be implemented at a large scale.

Investment projects

- To date a total of 24 projects have been approved. The statuses of the approved projects are as follows: 15 projects are under implementation, 5 projects are at various stages of contacting which are subjected to terms and conditions.
- **Three projects** were withdrawn as the projects failed to meet terms and conditions as per approval.
- **One project** has been discontinued as the project experience challenges during implementation.
- Total approved budget of **20 active projects** is approximately **R594** million, and current disbursement is **R 188 million**.
- It is projected that approximately of **12 712 jobs** will be created once the projects are fully implemented, noting that these are multiple year projects.





Research and Policy Development Initiatives

- A total of **16** research and policy development initiatives have been approved to a value of **R36** million.
- The contracting of all 16 projects has been undertaken and funds allocated to the research & development initiatives have been fully disbursed.

Capacity building Initiatives

- In order to sufficiently build an evidence base for transitioning to a green economy, the Green Fund supports strategic capacity building initiatives.
- Fund Management Committee has approved 5 capacity building projects in June 2014 for approximately R51 700 000 million.





Next Steps

- There will not be a further call for proposals.
- **Mapping exercise** will determine the gaps projects will be pursued through an **active origination process.**
- Life of the Fund beyond the funding period: Currently undertaking an independent analysis of the Fund, its performance, institutional capacity requirements, relevance of criteria & focus areas.
- Crowding in of investment Foreign Direct Investment, Private Sector, fiscal funding.
- Grants, loans, equity.
